

**JACKSON TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
SPECIAL BUDGET WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 12, 2020**

A.B. CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE:

The Board of Supervisors of Jackson Township held a Special Budget Workshop meeting on November 12, 2020 in the municipal building pursuant to public notice. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Holmes at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag. Others present were Supervisors Emily Miller and David Brown, Manager Florence Ford, Treasurer Sally Bushey, Secretary Linda Eaton, Public Works Foreman Shane Shaffer and one person in the audience.

C. PRESENTATION/PUBLIC COMMENT:

Chairman Holmes received a Thank You card along with photos from a group of Pickleball Enthusiasts. The group sent a BIG THANK YOU to the Board for providing an amazing park, and the awesome pickleball courts at the Little Creek Community Park.

D. APPROVAL OF BILLS:

All bills were approved for payment on a Brown/Miller motion. Motion carried 3-0.

E. NEW BUSINESS:

1. The Board reviewed and discussed the 2021 preliminary Township budget expected revenues and expenditures for the General, Sewer and Refuse, Liquid Fuels, Recreation Escrow, Local Services, Capital Reserve and WCREMA Funds which does not include a Real Estate Tax increase. The millage rate would remain at 1.8 mils for 2021.

Brad Dunham reviewed the Nashville Fire Company proposed funding budget for 2021. Brad thanked the Board for their support.

The following line item under the General Fund Expenditures was adjusted as follows:
Park Maintenance, Utilities and Improvements \$40,675.

2. The Spring Grove Regional Parks and Recreation Center's 2021 Budget was approved as submitted on a Miller/Brown motion. Motion carried 3-0.
3. The advertising and public display of the proposed budget at the Township Municipal Building and on the website www.jacksontownship.org will be on November 17, 2020, with an anticipated adoption at a special meeting to be held at 4:00 PM on December 14, 2020 at the Municipal Building on a Brown/Miller motion. Motion carried 3-0.

F. ADJOURNMENT:

With no further business to transact, the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM on motion of Brown/Miller, carried 3-0.
