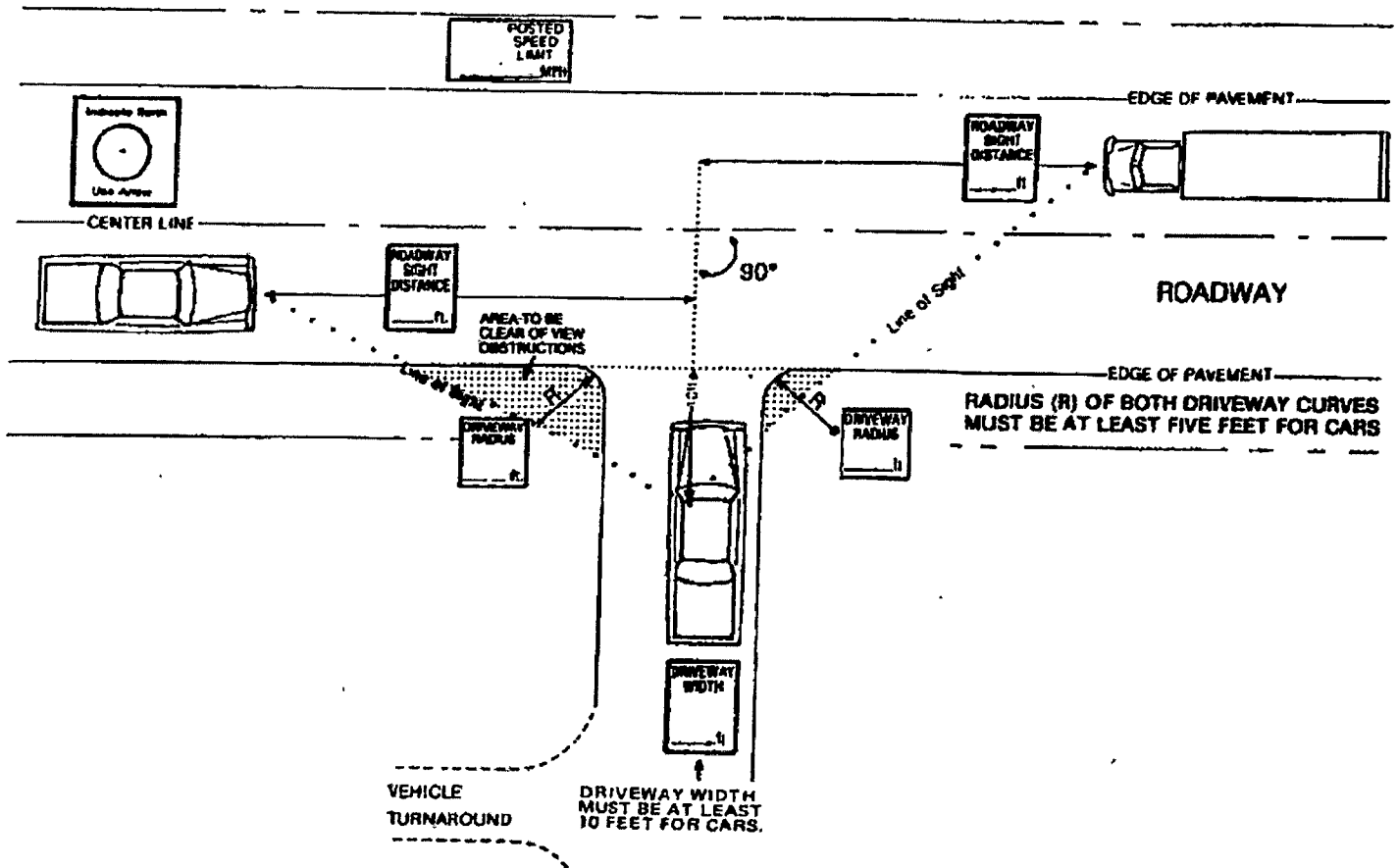

## **§ 133-34 Driveways**

**Width.** Within 10 feet of the street right of way, driveways may not exceed 20 feet in width.

**Number.** The number of driveways may not exceed two per lot on any one street frontage.

**Offsets.** Driveways may not enter a public street within:

- (1). Forty feet of the street right-of-way line of any intersecting street.
- (2). Five feet of a fire hydrant.
- (3). Twenty-five feet of another driveway on the same property.
- (4). Three feet of an adjoining property line.

**Sight Distances.** A driveway must be located in safe relationship to sight distance and barriers to vision as provided by PennDOT standards for safe stopping sight distances.

**Slope.** The driveway may not exceed a slope of 8% within 25 feet of the street right-of-way line.

**Paving.** The portion of a driveway within a street right-of-way and for a distance of 25 feet beyond that right-of-way shall be paved with a concrete, bituminous, or other paving material acceptable to the Township Engineer to prevent loose material from being carried onto the street.

**Cuts.** Where a driveway enters a bank through a cut, unless a retaining wall is used, the shoulders of the cut may not exceed 50% in slope within 25 feet of the point at which the driveway intersects the street right-of-way. The height of the bank must not exceed three feet within 10 feet of the roadway.

All lots must have a separate driveway located on the lot which the driveway serves. i.e., one driveway may not serve more than one lot, except for preexisting, land-locked lots of record.
