ORDINANCE NO. 227-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ITS CODE OF ORDINANCES BY REPEALING CHAPTER 107, ENTITLED "STORMWATER MANAGEMENT," IN ITS ENTIRETY AND REPLACING IT WITH A NEW CHAPTER 107, ATTACHED HERETO, WITH THE SAME TITLE, PROVIDING FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF STORMWATER WITHIN JACKSON TOWNSHIP AND SETTING FORTH PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SUCH REGULATIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT SO ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of Jackson Township, York County, Pennsylvania, by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 107, entitled "STORMWATER MANAGEMENT," of the Code of Ordinances of Jackson Township, York County, Pennsylvania, is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and adopting in its place as Chapter 107 of the Code of Ordinances of Jackson Township, York County, Pennsylvania, the attached document with the same title.

Section 2. Procedural Defects in Enactment.

Allegations that this Ordinance or any amendment was enacted in a procedurally defective manner shall be appealed as provided in Pennsylvania law.

Section 3. Enactment.

This Ordinance shall become effective in 5 calendar days, as provided by law.
